When you see a new bird or find a nest, record time, date, exact location and a brief description. Take a photo or record the song. Email findings to pokane@wisc.edu. A researcher will verify your report. Verified sightings will be added to survey and posted on Wild Warner's website.

This list of 140 species is the result of a 600-hour participatory research project led by Trish O'Kane, UW-Madison and supervised by Dr. Anna Pidgeon, UW-Madison Wildlife Ecology. Wild Warner, Madison-Audubon, UW-Madison, Madison College, Sherman Middle School students, and neighbors helped compile data.
